

**Bearded Pygmy Chameleons** - (*Rieppeleon brevicaudatus*) – Captive bred

**Diet** – Wax worms, crickets, meal worms, hydei, small silkworms, and phoenix worms. Any small prey, that will attract the attention of the chameleon and is not too large for them to eat.

**Housing** – At least a 10 gal is recommended for a pair. A partially covered screen lid will help keep the humidity up. Males should not be housed together as they might show aggression towards each other. Live plants help maintain the humidity in the tank and highways of thin sticks give the chameleons plenty of places to climb. Coco fiber or a similar substrate should be used on the bottom.

**Lighting** - UVB light are not necessary but there is no harm in having one. Backing lights are not necessary. Temperatures between 65F-78F are appropriate. The higher the temperature the higher the humidity needs to be. Heavy misting twice a day will help maintain humidity.
